Dear Parents and Carers

Visit to Manjushri Buddhist Temple (Conishead Priory)

The RE topic for this half term focuses on Buddhism. In order to enrich and deepen the children's understanding about Buddhism, a visit to the Manjushri Buddhist Temple, Ulverston, has been arranged for Years 3 and 4 on the following days:

Mr Tennant's Class and half of Miss Shaw's class - Monday 10th June

Ms. Thwaites and Mrs Brooks' class and half of Miss Shaw's class - Tuesday 11th June

(If your child is in Miss Shaw's class, please look out for the information slip of paper indicating the day your child's visit will take place).

The coach will leave school for Ulverston at 9am, returning to school at approximately 2.15pm, so the children are back in time for the end of the school day. Please ensure that your child is in school promptly on the day of their visit. Thank you.

The children will need to bring:

- Rucksack
- Packed lunch with a non-fizzy drink in screw-top plastic container (not glass)
- Waterproof jacket and sensible shoes

After visiting the temple and priory we will have a short walk through woodland to the beach. We will be doing this even if it is muddy and wet. Please ensure that your child comes dressed appropriately for the outdoor element of the visit. Sturdy shoes are essential and children can wear their own choice of comfortable clothes on their bottom half (e.g. leggings, joggers but NOT jeans please). All children should wear their school jumper. Should it be a sunny day, please ensure that your child has suncream already applied and a sunhat.

If your child requires medication for travel sickness, please can you ensure that they have taken this **before** they arrive at school **and have medication for the journey home**. *(Please ask the school office for an 'Administration of medicines' form)*. Any medicines should be handed in to the class teacher in a named envelope on the day of the visit.

In order for the visit to proceed, we request a voluntary contribution of **£11.00**. If we do not receive enough voluntary contributions, the visit may not be able to go ahead. If your child is in receipt of Pupil Premium Grant, the school will fund 75% of the visit. Voluntary contributions should be posted in the box at the school office in a **named envelope**, along with the consent form by Thursday 9th May. Cheques should be made payable to Castle Park School or online via our school money payment system.
