**KS1 EDUCATIONAL VISIT TO LOWTHER CASTLE**

As part of our topic this term about “Famous Castles”, we will be learning about how Lowther Castle compares to Kendal Castle. During our visit to Lowther Castle, part of the day will be spent drawing and imagining what the castle used to look like. - to wear school sweatshirt/cardigan and appropriate outdoor trousers/shorts
- sensible shoes and a waterproof coat or suncream/hat
- asthma inhaler if needed
- everything to be in a named rucksack

Each child will be allowed to bring a maximum of £5 spending money in a named purse/envelope, which they need to look after themselves.

If your child requires medication for travel sickness, please can you ensure that they have taken this **before** they arrive at school **and have medication for the journey home!** (Please ask the school office for an ‘Administration of medicines’ form). Any medicines should be handed in to the class teacher in a named envelope on the day of the visit.

In order for the visit to proceed, we request a voluntary contribution of £10. If we do not receive enough voluntary contributions, the visit will not be able to go ahead. If your child is in receipt of Pupil Premium Grant, the voluntary contribution requested is £2.50 and the school will fund the remaining 75% of the cost of the visit. Voluntary contributions should be posted in the box at the school office in a **named envelope**, along with the consent form before **Friday 21<sup>st</sup> June**. Cheques should be made payable to Castle Park School or online via our school money payment system.
