### Visit to Brockhole – The Lake District Visitor Centre

It's that time of the year again when we take our supported children for an exciting visit. This year, as we had such a good time last year, we have chosen to return to Brockhole on Windermere on **Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> July**, where we will play on the adventure playground, walk down to the Lake for some stone skipping, have a picnic lunch and a round of mini golf. In addition to these exciting activities we have also booked for the children and their support assistants to have an hour exploring the Treetop Nets.

We will transport the children in the community minibus or staff cars, leaving school **at 9.30a.m.** and returning for the end of the school day. Your child will register with their own class at the usual time and then their support assistant will bring them to the library before we set off.

Due to the nature of the trip, the children will need to have the clothing detailed below. They do not need school uniform, but denim should be avoided. They will also need a packed lunch and plenty to drink.

### The children will need to bring:

- Rucksack
- Packed lunch
- Non-fizzy drinks in screw-top plastic container (not glass)
- Waterproof jacket and sensible shoes or sunhat and sun cream
- A warm jumper if the weather is chilly

If your child requires medication for travel sickness, please ensure that they have taken this **before** they arrive at school and have some for the return journey. Please ask at the office for an 'Administration of Medicines Form' if your child will need staff to administer medicine for the journey back to school.

We are requesting a small voluntary contribution of **£6.00** to cover the cost of transport, parking charges and the mini golf. If your child is in receipt of Pupil Premium Grant, the voluntary contribution requested is **£1.50**.
